

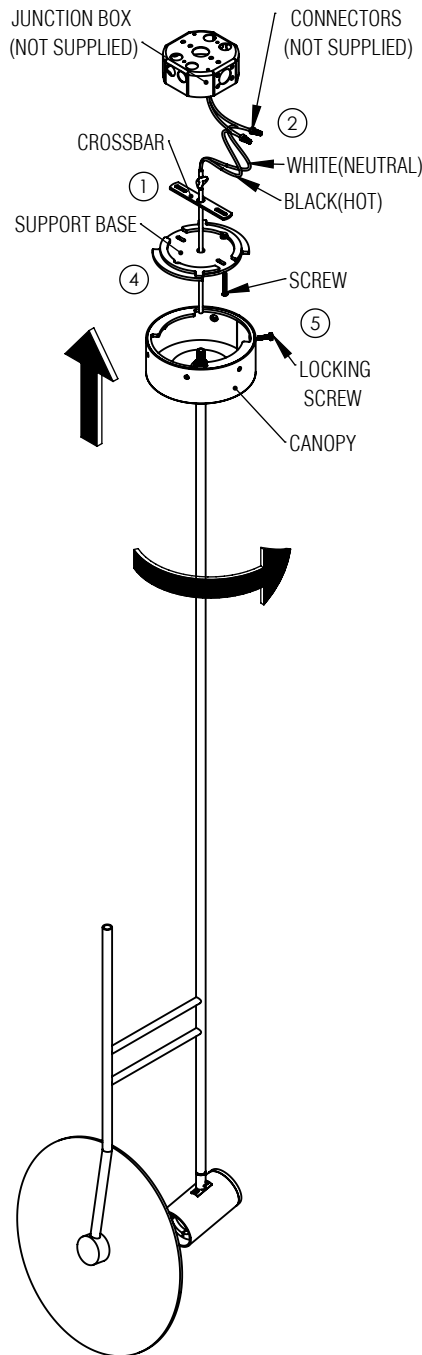
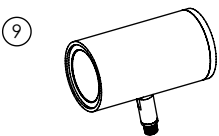
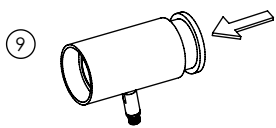
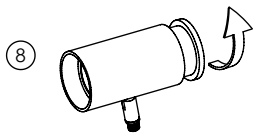
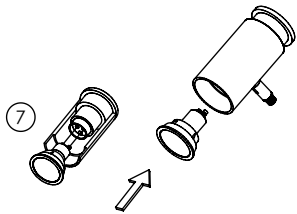
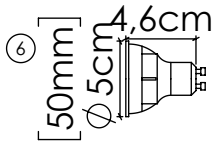
WARNING!

Ensure that the rated luminaire voltage requirements are compatible with the available mains supply in which it will be installed. All LEDs are included in your lamp. Never touch the LED surface with your bare hands as this may reduce the life of your LED. Do not alter, relocate or remove any electrical component.

MAKING ELECTRICAL CONNECTIONS

Turn OFF electrical power before beginning the installation process.

- ① Insert the electrical cable through the support base and crossbar.
- ② Connect the electrical supply wires to the junction box in accordance to all applicable local codes, as shown in the diagram.

MOUNTING ON THE FIXTURE

- ③ After electrical connections are made, place excess wire inside of the canopy and attach the support base and the crossbar to the junction box using the supplied screws.
- ④ Raise the luminaire until the canopy fits in the support base and rotate the luminaire in the indicated way until it brakes.
- ⑤ Fasten the locking screw in the indicated hole to stabilize the luminaire, preventing it to rotate.

INSTALLING THE BULB

- ⑥ Purchase a GU-10 bulb following the indicated dimensions.
- ⑦ Align the contact tips of the bulb with the socket holes and push the bulb so that the socket support base undock.
- ⑧ Rotate the socket support base in the indicated way, holding the bulb so that it fits in the socket.
- ⑨ After the bulb is already connected to the socket, push the socket support base fitting it to the luminaire. With the socket support base docked to the luminaire, the bulb installation is finished.

Turn ON the electrical power.
Your luminaire is now ready for use.
