WARNING!


Be sure electrical power is OFF before and during installation or maintenance. The luminaire must be installed by a qualified electrician, in accordance with all applicable Ensure that the rated luminaire voltage requirements are compatible with the available mains supply in which it will be installed.

All LEDS are included in your lamp. Never touch the LED surface with your bear hands as this may reduce the life of your LED.

Do not alter, relocate or remove any electrical component.

MOUNTING ON THE FIXTURE

Read carefully all the assembling instructions below and turn OFF energy power before starting the installation.

- (1) Remove the protecting package from the pieces taking care to not harm any parts with cutting surfaces or objects.
- (2) Install an A15 E26 light bulb, with a maximum wattage rating of 25W. While holding the metal brackets up, insert the glass globe on one of its ends, carefully sliding it in and releasing tension, taking care to not damage the globe. Repeat this process with the other side. Releasing the bracket, the globe will be attached to the holder.
- (3) After the lamp and glass globe installation is complete, use the power switch tp turn ON/OFF.

Your luminaire is ready for use.

SAFETY WHEN CONNECTING TO THE MAINS

This luminaire has a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other) as a safety feature to reduce the risk of electrical shock. This plug will fit in a polarized outlet only one way. If the plug does not fit fully in the outlet, reverse the plug. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified eletrician. Never use with adapters or extension cords unless the plug can be fully inserted. Do not alter the plug.



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
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
