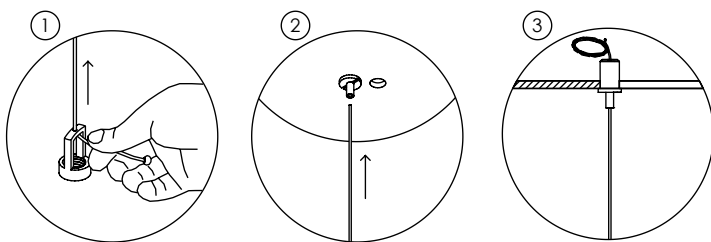

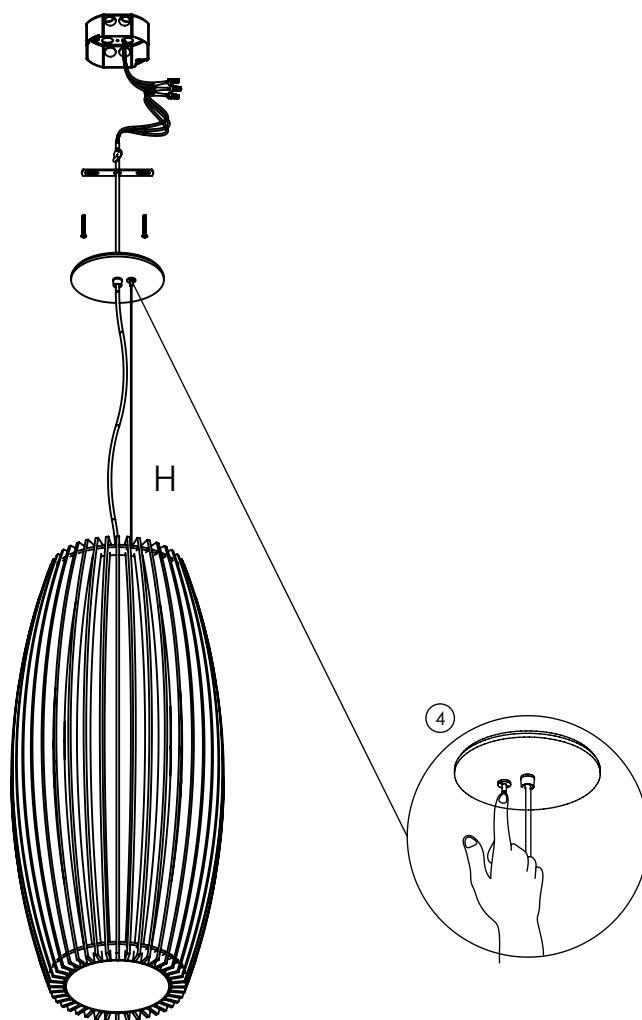
INSTALLING THE FIXTURE ON CEILING

Turn OFF the power before start the installation.

- ① Pass the support steel cable through the small hole in the screw collar loop mounted on top of the luminaire. Ensure the ball-end of the cable stays inside of the loop in order to secure it in place.
- ② Insert the other end of the support steel cable into the adjustable anchor mounted on the canopy until it is tight.
- ③ Reserve extra cable by wrapping it inside of the canopy. It is not necessary to cut the excess off, but ensure that the cable cannot touch any of the electrical connections.
- ④ After the canopy assembly is finished, level the fixture by making adjustments to the length of the cable as shown in the next step.

ADJUSTING THE FIXTURE HEIGHT

Choose the height (H) you want the luminaire to hang below the ceiling by pushing on the anchor to release tension. While pressing the tip, move the cable until it reaches the desired length. Release the tip and the cable will be locked again. Final adjustments can be made after the fixture is mounted.
Now you are ready to make the electrical connection.

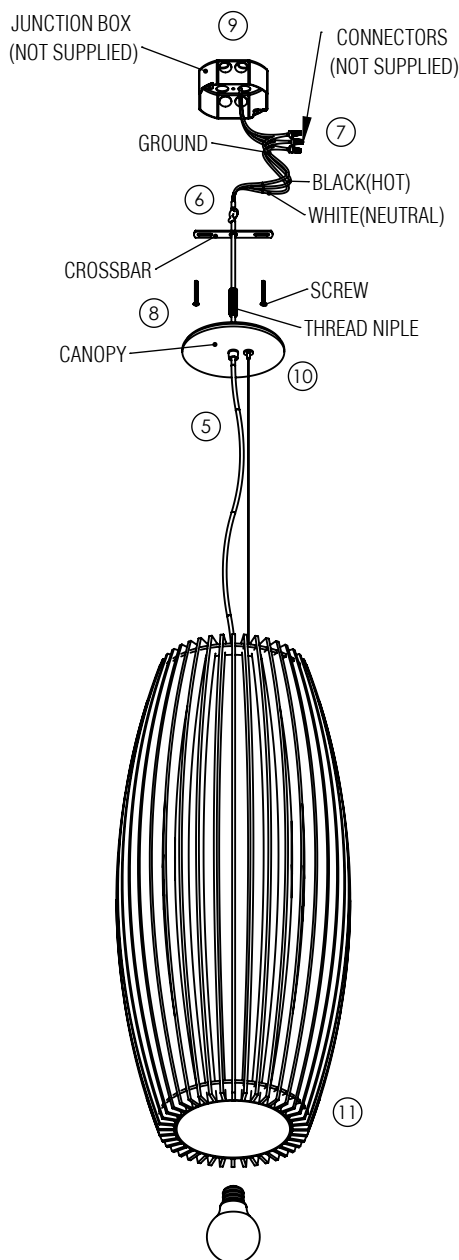

INSTALLING THE FIXTURE ON CEILING

Turn OFF the power before start the installation.

- ⑤ Insert the electrical cable through the conical cable gland, nipple, canopy and crossbar.
- ⑥ Adjust the length of the electrical cable by attaching a knot to keep the luminaire at the desired height.
- ⑦ Connect the power supply wires to the junction, in accordance with applicable local standards, as shown in the diagram opposite.
- ⑧ Screw the crossbar into the junction box using the screws provided.

ADJUSTING THE FIXTURE HEIGHT

- ⑨ After making the electrical connection, insert the excess wire into the junction box.
- ⑩ Bring the canopy to the ceiling and secure it by screwing the conical thread pass with the nipple to the crossbar, until everything is safe on the ceiling.
- ⑪ Once the luminaire is suspended and level, install the lamp (not included) in socket E-26 fixed on the nozzle base.

Turn ON electrical power.

Your luminaire is now ready for use.



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
