

### ASSEMBLING THE FIXTURE

Turn off the electrical power before starting the installation, and keep it turned off until the installation is completed.

This assembly may require the work of two people so it can be secure and well executed.

- Insert the suspension cable on the hole at the top of the fixture. leaving the ball-end on the bottom, anchoring the fixture.
- Then insert the other end of the suspension cable at the adjustable cable gripper on the canopy. To insert the cable and adjust the height, press the tip of the gripper while simultaneously sliding the cable in. When you release it, the gripper will lock the cable and anchor the fixture. Repeat this process with all the grippers, adjusting the height and leveling the fixture. Reserve the extra cables by wrapping it, or cut the excess. Keep in mind that if you cut it, it will limit the height adjustments in the future.
- (3) Pass the power supply cable through the strain relief (S), threaded tube nipple (N), canopy (C), junction box cover (J) and crossbar (CB). Adjust the cable length so it is equivalent to the desired heigh for the luminaire to be installed.
- (4) Make the electrical connections in compliance with all the safety standards and local electrical codes. This product must be installed in accordance with the applicable installation code by a person familiar with the construction and operation of the product, and the hazards involved.
- (5) Using the (S1) screws, fixate the crossbar into the junction box.
- (6) Fixate the threaded nipple into the crossbar through the center hole of the canopy. Bring the canopy close to the junction box, fitting the nipple in its center hole. Using the strain relief, fixate them into the nipple. Once its secure, tighten the screw on the strain relief to anchor the power cord.
- Remove the diffuser globe by unscrewing it from the metal support, counter clockwise. Install an E27 A45 lightbulb (not included) taking care to not exceed the recommended wattage rating of 25W. Insert the diffuser globe at the support and lock it in place, twisting it clockwise.

Turn on the electrical power.

The luminaire is ready for use.
